

EXPENSE BREAKDOWN





IGNITE

Ignite is our in-house middle school retreat, a church-wide effort every other year to intentionally invest in this generation. This year, 87 students were led by 42 high school leaders and supported by more than 50 adult volunteers. Over the weekend, students worshiped, prayed, connected in small groups and discovered what a solid foundation of faith means for their future.














FAMILY NIGHT OF WORSHIP

MOUNT PAKA

A trip to Mount Paka with John Tanner, Manh Dang and Shannon was a full-circle moment.

A previous **Big Give** brought clean drinking water to the Pokot community on Mt. Paka, Kenya. It's an area that had no reliable water source and no gospel presence. When a well was provided, everything changed. The community was able to stabilize and grow, creating the opportunity and eventually the need for a pastor and church.

The crowd of people who came to the grand opening of the church on Mt. Paka was truly remarkable. They are now receiving the **living water** because they are learning about Jesus.

GLOBAL MISSIONS

THAILAND

In the summer of 2025, Shannon saw firsthand the impact our **mission partners in Thailand** are making. The situation in the country is dark. The children they work with either have been, or are at risk of being, human trafficked, often by members of their own families.

In a country where 97% of the population is Buddhist, the belief in reincarnation can lead to decisions in this lifetime that are difficult for us to comprehend. Our mission partners are responding by **sharing the love and ways of Jesus**, one child at a time. Their ministry continues to grow, and lives are being changed as a result of their heart to help those they encounter.








LOCAL MISSIONS

2ND SATURDAY SERVE DAYS


2nd Saturday Serve Days continue to be a time when our congregations visit a local mission partner to learn more about what they do. These **hands-on introductions** often lead to our people volunteering directly with the ministry going forward.



Nueva Vida is a ministry within Cove Church Ministries that focuses on **gospel-centered transformation** within the local Latino community. More than 60 people gathered to learn English and hear the gospel each week at Nueva Vida's ESOL program.

Nueva Vida also serves in the community in partnership with Camino Alliance to reach underserved families, provide pastoral care and develop new leaders within Huntsville's Latino community.





\$179,463.76 DONATED TO THE 2024 BIG GIVE

The Big Give is a CCM-wide annual campaign that provides help and hope on a global and local scale. Your 2024-2025 contributions supported Samaritan's Purse.

RECIPIENT

For 2024, our recipient was **Samaritan's Purse**. They are heroes to those who unexpectedly find themselves in the center of catastrophic natural disasters and have helped thousands recover from the devastation Hurricanes Helene and Milton left behind.

Helene alone left a 500-mile trail of devastation from the **Gulf Coast of Florida** to the mountains of **western North Carolina**.

Funds from the 2024 Big Give went **directly to Samaritan's Purse** to support these critical disaster relief efforts.

Since 2006, our church family has raised more than \$3.1 million through The Big Give campaign.



YOUR IMPACT THROUGH SAMARITAN'S PURSE

Across six sites in Florida, Georgia & North Carolina, their U.S. Disaster Relief teams assisted **7,217 families** and witnessed **439 people** come to faith in Jesus. Nearly **40,500 volunteers** served with them.

Samaritan's Purse flew **358 airlift missions** and completed **242 ground deliveries** across **23 counties** in western North Carolina and eastern Tennessee to deliver relief supplies to **160 communities**.

North Carolina's Buncombe and Yancey counties were provided with **500,391 liters** of clean water.


